

Emeritus Society Legacy of Excellence Award

Purpose: To recognize outstanding an emeriti whose contributions to Academia, the University, and the Community after retirement.

Eligibility:

1. The faculty member should have been retired for five years, that is, without getting paid for his or her efforts (this is similar to other Halls of Fame) and
2. The faculty member has continued on an unpaid basis to contribute to their department, college, or the university.

Criteria for Award:

- Sustained contributions to Academia
- Continued service to the University, community and mankind
- Personal accomplishments in retirement which serve as a role model to other retirees

Nominations: To nominate an individual for this award, complete the form below along with a statement explaining why you believe the nominee deserves recognition.

Nominations are due no later than February 1 of the award year.

Selection: A committee appointed by the Emeritus Director will review the nominations and make the selection. The recipient will receive an appropriate recognition gift which will be presented at the Annual Showcase Retirees Reception in March. The committee reserves the right not to name a recipient.
