

## Psychology as a Second Degree

**If you are currently majoring in another department and desire to have a second degree in Psychology, the following steps must be completed:**

- Maintain a 2.50 cumulative GPA and complete Psych 311 with a "C-" or better for a B.S. in Psychology
- Maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA for a B.A. in Psychology
- Deliver a copy of your WSU transcript, high school transcript, and Report(s) of Advanced Standing (if you have transfer work) to JT 233.
- At least two semesters before graduation, complete an "Undergraduate and Professional Degree Application" for a second degree, available at the Psychology Department's main office, JT 233. Take the completed form to the Cashier's Office, French Administration, Room 240, and pay the application fee.
- Take the PAID application to the Registrar's Office, French Administration, Room 346. This will generate a "To-Do List" which indicates the courses you need to complete to graduate with a second degree in Psychology. The "To-Do-List" will be available for you to pick up in Johnson Tower 233 approximately one to two months following submission of the application.
- Complete all of the requirements for the Psychology Department, including all GER (General Education Requirements) for the College of Liberal Arts.
- Upon completion of all coursework and completion of 150 semester hours, your transcript will indicate that you have a second degree in Psychology.
